We continue to make strides improving our balance sheet, infrastructure and "core" products for our members. The reported loss for year ending 2010 is directly related to a Member Business Loan that we needed to set aside monies for in the loan loss reserve due to it being unsecured. Prior to this provision the Credit Union was on track to report a \$325,000 net income for 2010. Despite this setback the Credit Union remains "Well Capitalized" and financially strong. We continue to work closely with our regulator, the NCUA, to enable us to move forward with member business loans in the near future.

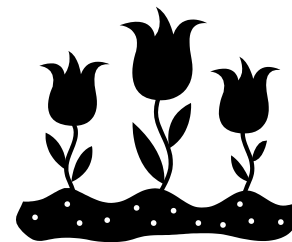

Make Your Banking Habits "Greener"

- **Start using Online Banking and Bill Pay** – Checking your accounts online is convenient. By paying bills online, you can save money on postage and reduce the possibility of identity fraud.
- **Turn off your paper statement** – Are you checking your account online and then just throwing that paper statement in the drawer? Contact any USSCO office to have that paper statement eliminated. E-Statements are available through Home Banking the first day of each statement period.
- **Switch to Direct Deposit** – Money is deposited directly to your USSCO account.
- **Advantage E-Mail** – USSCO will notify you via an e-mail of Insufficient Funds notices, Overdraft Transfer notices, Overdraft Limit processing, notification of payroll and direct deposit (ACH) deposit postings, and direct (ACH) debit postings, certificate renewals, redemption and maturity notices, loan payment reminders and low or high share balance notices. You must provide your preferred e-mail address and which notices you would like to receive during the Home Banking login process.
- **Remote Deposit** – Business owners can scan and deposit checks to their USSCO account from the convenience of your business. Contact one of the Business Development Team for details.
