- Each USSCO member is individually insured up to \$250,000 per federally-insured credit union. Joint account holders are insured up to \$250,000 per joint account holder. Any joint accounts are insured separately from individual accounts.
- USSCO Retirement accounts, like IRAs, are also insured up to \$250,000 and insured separately from all other accounts.
- USSCO Non- interest bearing accounts (Checking Accounts) are temporarily insured (through December 2012) separately for an unlimited amount.
